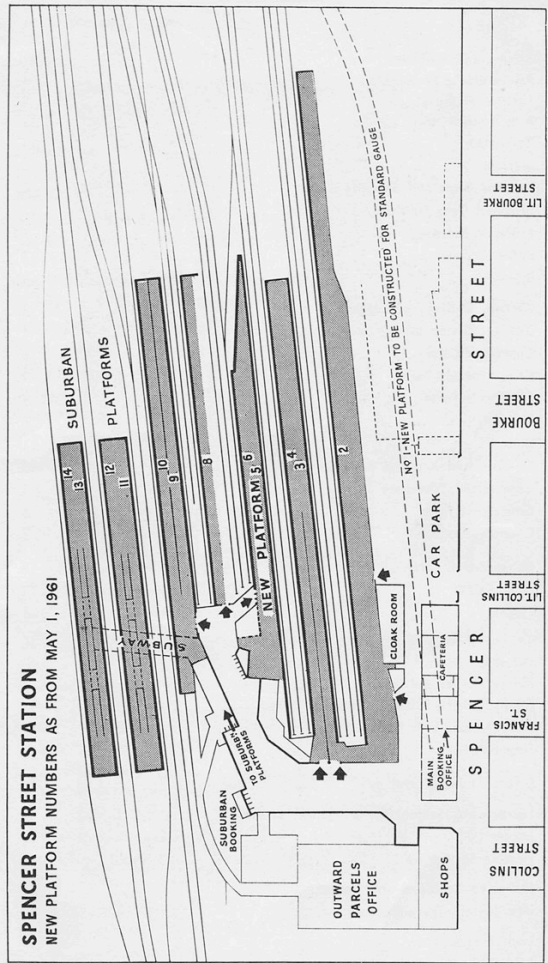

THE Victorian Railways have pleasure in presenting this time-table to help you obtain the utmost benefit from railway planned service.

It also covers country fares, luggage hints, details of seat and sleeping berth reservations, facilities for meals and refreshments, parcels rates and other useful information.

You will find travel comfort at its best when you relax in an air-conditioned carriage, eat a snack in a buffet car, or settle between the fresh sheets of a sleeping berth.

Drinking water and toilet facilities, taken for granted by rail travellers are, of course, provided in all country carriages. Passengers can relax in their seats or, if they feel inclined, stroll along the corridors at any time.

Rail travel is safe, sure and so restful.

TIME-TABLE ALTERATIONS—As far as practicable, schedules will be altered only on the first Mondays of May and November, when new time-tables, designated "Winter" and "Summer" respectively will be issued. Should you wish to check any time-table details you can do so by contacting your local Stationmaster, or by telephoning 63 0202 if you are in the metropolitan area, before beginning your journey. Mention your destination station—not merely the line on which you are travelling.

During **HOLIDAY PERIODS**, schedules are altered or augmented to handle the heavier traffic.

You may **TRAVEL BY SOME GOODS TRAINS**, subject to certain conditions which can be ascertained at any station.

SPECIAL TRAINS can be arranged under certain conditions. Telephone, write to, or call on the Superintendent of Train Services, Railways Administrative Offices, Spencer Street. For details of country trains ring 62 0311 extension 1147; for suburban trains, extension 1676.

CHILDREN'S FARES—Children under four years are carried free; four or over but under fourteen years, at half-fare. On Sunday country excursion trains, children under 16 years of age, with an adult, pay only one-quarter of the adult day-return fare (maximum five children to each adult fare passenger). (See pages 36 and 37).

FRACTIONAL PARTS of days are charged as one day. Fractions less than a half-penny are ignored. A half-penny or over is charged as one penny. Under half-a-mile is ignored, half-a-mile or over is reckoned a mile. There are some exceptions to these rules. Fractions of 1 lb. under $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. are not charged for.

CHANGE—You can help to prevent delay, especially on busy occasions and avoid missing your train, by handing the booking clerk the exact amount or as near the exact amount of the fare as possible. It's not always possible to give change.

MISTAKES made at the booking window are difficult to adjust if not immediately reported. Please examine your change and ticket before leaving the window—it will enable any errors to be promptly rectified.

ENTERING OR ALIGHTING FROM TRAINS IN MOTION—Never attempt to enter or alight from a train in motion. If you do you endanger your life and possibly the lives of others.

LOST PROPERTY—If you have the misfortune to lose any property on railway premises or in carriages, report the matter immediately to the officials. A thorough search will be made and the property, if found, returned to you on payment of any prescribed charges. Usually, there is no charge if it is claimed on the day it is found or on the following day.

The Lost Property Office at Flinders Street station is open from 6 a.m. to 11.45 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, and from 8 a.m. to 11.45 p.m. on Sundays. At Spencer Street station the Lost Property Office is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Mondays to Fridays and from 8 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays.

ARTICLES FOUND IN THE CARRIAGE OR ON RAILWAY PREMISES must be handed to the stationmaster or guard at the first opportunity; otherwise you may incur a penalty of £5.

DON'T OFFER TIPS to railwaymen. It is their duty to see to all reasonable travelling requirements.

COMMERCIAL TRAVELLERS' SAMPLES—A special concession is granted commercial travellers for genuine samples, properly packed in approved containers bearing the name of the firm and traveller. Commercial travellers, with first-class tickets, may carry 2 cwt. of samples and personal luggage combined; with second-class tickets, 1½ cwt. Excess payment is necessary if these limits are exceeded. For rates and conditions, inquire at stations. Commercial travellers' samples must not be sold or otherwise disposed of on the trip.

PERISHABLE FOOD-STUFFS AND CERTAIN COUNTRY PRODUCE are carried at special low rates. You can obtain fresh food from the country at half ordinary parcels rates by passenger train. Lower rates are charged if consignments are sent by goods train. If desired, stationmasters will arrange for the goods to be delivered at your home in Melbourne or suburbs. Full particulars may be obtained at your local station.

BICYCLES—When your bicycle accompanies you on the train, a lower rate is charged than for unaccompanied machines. Parcels rates are charged for motor cycles when unaccompanied by owners; half parcels rates when accompanied. Remove the petrol from your cycle tank, and disconnect the battery wires. This will prevent risk of fire and comply with the By-laws.

DOGS may be sent by passenger train in the van only. A chain and properly fitting collar must be provided, except in the case of small dogs or puppies in a crate or box. They should be fully addressed (with telephone number, if possible). Freight must be prepaid in all cases.

BY-LAWS—The Railways By-laws are designed to ensure the safety and comfort of rail travellers. A copy of them may be inspected at any railway station. All traffic is carried subject to the Railways Acts and By-laws.

INTER-SYSTEM TRAVELLING—When travelling by rail outside Victoria, you are advised to make yourself familiar with railway conditions in other states.

"DRIVE YOURSELF" CAR SERVICE—When travelling to Melbourne, Mildura or most interstate capitals, rail passengers can arrange for a "drive yourself" car to be available on arrival of the train. Cars can be reserved at the time of purchasing rail tickets or by making inquiry from the conductor of the train.

INFORMATION—If there is anything else you would like to know, please ask your stationmaster. He will gladly give you the information or direct you to the office concerned.

TICKETS and FARES

COUNTRY tickets are sold at certain suburban stations. See page 14, Bargain Sunday day-return fares are given on Pages 36 and 37.

"OFF-PEAK" TICKETS at reduced fares are issued Mondays to Fridays inclusive (public holidays excepted) to Melbourne from suburban stations including stations on the Frankston, Upper Ferntree Gully, Lilydale and Hurstbridge lines. These tickets are available for travel by trains timed to arrive at Flinders Street or Princes Bridge not earlier than 9.30 a.m. and not later than 4 p.m. and may be used on the return journey at any time except by trains leaving Flinders Street or Princes Bridge between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.

PERIODICAL TICKETS are issued subject to certain conditions. Full particulars are available at all stations or the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau. Such tickets do not entitle you to travel by private or guaranteed special trains.

REFUND OF DEPOSITS on periodical tickets will be granted if you return the ticket to the Department within seven days of the date of expiry.

WEEKLY TICKETS are issued to Melbourne from suburban stations and from country stations within a radius of 27 miles of Melbourne, and between any two stations within such radius. The week begins on Sunday, but the tickets may also be purchased on any day up to the following Thursday inclusive. All tickets expire on the Saturday following the date of issue.

IF YOU CANNOT PRODUCE YOUR PERIODICAL TICKET you must pay the ordinary fare.

BARRIER SYSTEM AND PLATFORM TICKETS—At certain stations the public cannot be allowed free entrance to the passenger platform. A notice to this effect is posted at the barrier of stations concerned. If you are not travelling and wish to go on to the platform at such stations, you can buy a platform ticket. Your platform ticket does not entitle you to a seat in the train. A charge of 6d. is made for each platform ticket.

LOST TICKETS—The loss of your ticket does not entitle you to any refund. Duplicate periodical tickets (weekly excepted) are, however, issued under certain conditions.

UNUSED TICKETS—With the exception of daily suburban tickets you can obtain a refund on your unused, unexpired ticket under certain conditions.

CONCESSION FARES are granted for large parties, such as athletic bodies, etc. Make full inquiries at your local station. Itineraries are prepared and all travel arrangements made for tours of clubs, sporting bodies, etc. Consult the Chief Commercial Manager, Railways Offices, Spencer Street, (Phone 62 0311 ext. 1346) who has special organizers available to discuss school and club problems.

STUDENTS' CONCESSIONS—On production of certificates from authorized educational establishments, students (not in employment) are allowed fare concessions when travelling to their studies, on vacation, or at weekends during school periods. If you require information, inquire at your college, school, university, local railway station or consult the Chief Commercial Manager.

PASSENGERS TRAVELLING WITHOUT TICKETS are liable to be prosecuted.

CHANGE OF CLASS—To change your tickets from second to first class, you pay excess fare before commencing the journey.

EXTENSION OF JOURNEY—To travel beyond the station to which your ticket is available, you pay excess fare before commencing the journey.

HIKERS' TICKETS—Special "round tour" rail tickets are on issue. They cover a forward journey from Melbourne to a station on one line and a return journey from a station on another line. This enables hikers to plan cross-country tours that do not involve a re-tracing of steps to the starting point for return by train to the city. Get particulars at the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, or consult the Chief Commercial Manager.

A week's extension can be arranged for half the original cost.

Half fare for children under 14 years and Students' vacation concessions are available on application to Chief Commercial Manager, Administrative Buildings, Spencer Street, Melbourne.

Tickets are obtainable on any day at the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, and at Flinders Street, Spencer Street, Geelong, Ballarat, Bendigo, Seymour, Warragul and Mildura stations, and at other stations on two days' notice.

FAMILY TICKETS

FAMILY tickets to Melbourne's seaside beaches are on issue at all suburban stations from October 1 to April 30 (Cup Day excepted) at exceptionally cheap rates, each ticket covering the travel of two adults and four children (under 16) or one adult and five children.

Family tickets to the Zoological Gardens (rail to Royal Park station) are on issue throughout the year, Cup Day excepted.

Family tickets to hill resorts are on issue on Sundays throughout the year.

AVAILABILITY OF VICTORIAN TICKETS AND BREAK OF JOURNEY CONDITIONS

SINGLE (ORDINARY) TICKETS, COUNTRY LINES—The journey must be commenced on the date stamped on the ticket, but may be broken at any intermediate country station and at Melbourne (when the journey necessitates passing through Melbourne), provided the whole of it is completed within seven days.

ORDINARY RETURN TICKETS, COUNTRY LINES—The forward journey must be commenced on the date stamped on the ticket, but may be broken at any intermediate country station and at Melbourne (when the journey necessitates passing through Melbourne), provided the forward journey is completed within seven days. The return journey may be broken in the same way, but in this instance the whole trip need not be completed until one calendar month from the date of issue stamped on the ticket.

LUGGAGE INFORMATION

FREE LUGGAGE consists of wearing apparel and other similar personal belongings contained in a trunk, portmanteau, kit-bag, valise, suit case, or in any other receptacle commonly used for the purpose.

Bona fide passengers' luggage contained in tea chests, cartons, cases or parcels may be accepted for transit under the conditions applicable to passengers' luggage, provided that if there be any doubt, passengers shall be requested to open packages for inspection.

Parcels of luggage must not be carried in brake-vans.

If you claim your luggage at your destination on arrival of the train you will avoid cloak-room charges.

YOUR FREE LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE is 112 lb., if you are travelling first class, and 84 lb., second class. Half these weights are allowed on children's tickets.

If you are travelling to another State you are granted a luggage allowance of 168 lb., first class, and 112 lb., second class.

Overseas passengers both inward and outward, are entitled to the free carriage by rail of the following luggage—

First class, 3 cwt.	Second class, 2 cwt.

To obtain this concession, the following must be presented at the Station-master's Office, Spencer Street or Flinders Street, or the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, 272 Collins Street, Melbourne:—

Inward Passenger—Ship Purser's certificate and rail ticket.

Outward Passenger—Steamer ticket and rail ticket.

EXCESS LUGGAGE is charged at ordinary parcels rates on the bulk weight.

LUGGAGE INFORMATION (cont.)

LUGGAGE FOR CONVEYANCE IN VANS—Luggage to go by brake-van should be securely packed and clearly addressed to the destination station. Remove all old labels and help to prevent your luggage going astray. All luggage should be presented with your ticket for checking at least 30 minutes before the train leaves.

COUNTRY AND INTER-SYSTEM PASSENGERS—Passengers travelling from country or inter-system stations may book their luggage through to a suburban station without charge.

SECURE LUGGAGE CHECKS FOR YOUR LUGGAGE—Luggage checks are used in Victoria and for inter-system traffic. The checks are stout card, half of which is attached to the bag, and half is held by you during your journey. A check is issued for each package of bona fide luggage you send in the brake-van. On arriving at your destination you will receive your luggage on surrendering your portion of the check.

Always note the number of your checks—this is a safeguard, if they are lost.

In the event of luggage going astray owing to the address label becoming detached in transit, it will facilitate recovery if you have placed inside the luggage the same address as appears on the outside.

BANISH LUGGAGE BOTHER—Leave your order at the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, or telephone the Railways Road Carrier (69 0180) to take your luggage from your home. Let him see your rail ticket, when he will issue you the necessary luggage checks. Then you can forget the luggage until you reach your rail destination.

If travelling to Ballarat, Geelong, Bendigo, Sydney or Adelaide, your luggage will be delivered at the street address in those cities. All you need do is to see that a legibly addressed label is securely attached to each piece of luggage.

When returning to Melbourne, write your private address and "For delivery by Railways Road Carrier" on the label. The luggage will then be delivered to your door.

A set scale of charges is made for this convenient service from door to door.

If preferred, you may book your luggage direct from any suburban station to a country or inter-system station, or vice versa. Just produce your tickets for the through journey at the local station and your luggage will then be cared for in the brake-van until you reach your destination station.

Insurance rates to other interstate stations vary with mileage.

The Railways' liability on uninsured checked or excess luggage, lost or damaged, is limited to £10.

For further information, inquire from stationmasters.

DANGEROUS GOODS must not be packed with your luggage. They are accepted for carriage only under special conditions which may be ascertained at any station. Should you neglect to indicate distinctly the nature of the contents on the outside of a package containing dangerous goods, or should you leave dangerous goods with an official and fail to advise him in writing regarding their nature, you are liable to a penalty not exceeding £20.

BULKY ARTICLES OF LUGGAGE—Luggage containers which are to be taken into the railway carriage must be of suitable size and shape to be safely stowed in the racks. Luggage is not allowed in the vestibule or corridors of carriages, as it can cause inconvenience to other passengers.

Articles exceeding either 26 inches long, 16 inches wide, or 9 inches deep must be carried in the brake-van. Obtain a luggage check for such articles.

The **RED CAP MEN** are **LUGGAGE PORTERS**, and are licensed to assist you with your luggage at Spencer Street and Flinders Street stations. Licensed luggage porters are entitled to be paid at the following rates and no more—(a) When a single article of luggage only has to be transported—1/- (b) For each additional article—6d.

Maximum charge for luggage for any one passenger is 3/-.

CLOAK ROOM HOURS—Flinders Street, 6 a.m. to 11.50 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays, 8 a.m. to 11.50 p.m. Sundays; Spencer Street 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, 6 a.m. to 11.30 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays 8.15 a.m. to 10 p.m. You may leave your parcels or personal belongings at any railway station where an official is in charge. Elevenpence is charged for each article left to be collected the next day; lower daily rates are charged for longer periods than three days. Inquire at booking offices or cloak rooms for further particulars.

HELP TO PREVENT YOUR PARCELS AND LUGGAGE GOING ASTRAY

Many parcels and much luggage are lost each year through—

- 1 Insecure and insufficient packing.
 - 2 Insufficient and illegible addresses.
 - 3 Old brands, addresses and labels not being removed or obliterated.
 - 4 Luggage checks not being obtained.
- Remember—Pack securely and address fully (labels are available free at stations); also place address inside luggage.

CLAIMS should be made promptly and in writing. State your case clearly, giving the stations from and to which consignments were sent, names of sender and consignee, date of consigning, and indicate whether sent by goods or passenger train. Save yourself inconvenience and delay by following the directions issued for your guidance when forwarding parcels and luggage.

PARCELS

ADDRESSING PARCELS—Be sure that all parcels are fully and legibly addressed, in ink where possible, showing the station from which delivery is desired, also the street and house number.

Labels are available free at stations.

If you **PREPAY FREIGHT** on parcels by means of parcels freight stamps, you save a 25 per cent booking fee.

FREIGHT STAMPS are issued in various denominations up to ten shillings. Keep a supply in hand.

Freight charges on parcels forwarded to caretaker and no-one-in-charge stations must be prepaid.

CHEAP RATES FOR LIGHT PARCELS BY PASSENGER TRAIN—Specially cheap rates are quoted for the carriage of light parcels by passenger train. The charge for an ordinary parcel weighing 1 lb. for any distance is 1/- freight prepaid, and proportionately lower rates are charged for heavier weights. For further information regarding rates, inquire at local station.

BRITTLE AND FRAGILE ARTICLES, AND PACKAGES which are bulky in proportion to their weight, are charged 50 per cent more than ordinary parcels rates.

DELIVERY BY CARRIER—All parcels, packages, or consignments fully addressed with consignee's name, number of house, name of street and suburb, and consigned by goods or passenger train to Melbourne, will be delivered by carrier except to certain outlying suburban districts not served by carrier. For rates and conditions inquire at your local station.

When this metropolitan door to door delivery is not desired, the words "To be called for" should be added.

RESERVED SEATS AND COMPARTMENTS

Seats may be reserved for travel by certain specified trains on payment of a small booking fee. (See pages 15 to 20 for further information.)
A reserved compartment may be booked on certain trains, provided there is room, by paying six first class or eight second class adult fares. This payment allows up to six or eight persons to travel first or second class respectively.

SLEEPING BERTH and SEAT RESERVATIONS

Unless otherwise stated, reservations for stations in the Victorian system can be made up to one calendar month in advance.

Passengers to Sydney, Canberra, Brisbane, Adelaide, Kalgoorlie and Perth can book twelve months ahead on the forward journey, and thirteen months ahead for their return.

For other interstate stations, bookings are two months in advance on the forward trip and three months for return.

Country residents (outside the suburban electrified area) may make advance bookings by contacting their local Stationmaster a few days before the bookings open in Melbourne, or by writing to the Stationmaster at Spencer Street or Flinders Street, or to the Manager of the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, Melbourne or at Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong or Mildura.

Seats and/or sleeping berths may be reserved at the Victorian Government Tourist Bureau, 272 Collins Street, Melbourne; at Spencer Street station, Flinders Street station or at certain suburban stations (see page 14).

In sleeping carriages (excepting "Roomettes") on the Adelaide and Mildura lines basinettes are available free to mothers, with babies, who are booked in sleeping berths.

When a basinette is required, the Stationmaster at Spencer Street should be advised prior to travel; or one may be obtained, on the train, from the Conductor.
