MELBOURNE-DIMBOOLA-SERVICETON.

SERVICE: -

On Monday 9th August, 1937; the existing Mixed Goods Train Services operating between Dimboola and Serviceton were withdrawn and were replaced by a Petrol Electric Rail Motor and Trailer which provided a Daily Passenger Service between these two points, and giving connection at Dimboola with Main Line Steam Passenger Trains to and from Melbourne.

Due to an extreme Coal and Fuel shortage; steam passenger services were curtailed and to provide a daily connection with passenger trains to and from Melbourne the service operated between Serviceton and Dimboola Mon, Wed, Fri and Sat and between Serviceton and Horsham on Tuesdays and Thursdays. This service operated from 23rd June, 1949 until 7th September, 1949 when normal services were resumed.

On and after 13th September, 1949 the service was provided by a Petrol Electric Rail Motor only. The Trailer being withdrawn for service elsewhere.

Once again, the incidence of Coal & Fuel shortages made it necessary to extend the Rail Motor service to give the necessary connections to and from Melbourne. To enable this operation to be effectively carried out, the Rail Motor service operated between Serviceton and Ararat Mon, Wed, Fri and Sats. The service was cancelled on Tuesdays and Thursdays. This service operated from 26th February, 1951 until 9th April, 1951.


After completion of trip on 18th March, 1953; the Petrol Electric Rail Motor was withdrawn from service and was replaced by a Walker Type 103 HP Diesel Rail Car and Trailer. There was no alteration to existing schedules.






